Seiko 6139 Pogue. Some may consider the 6139 "Pogue" to be a bit of an eccentric selection within our top 10 Vintage Seiko watches list, but I'm ready to defend the choice. First, if the "Pogue" isn't the cheapest vintage space flown watch (it went up with Col. William Pogue in 1973 as part of Skylab), it has to be in the running.
